## 1. June Meeting Minutes

Ann Lygas, past President and current Vice-President (Federation) called the meeting to order and welcomed guests. President Laura Collins was not present because she was attending the GFWC International Convention. The motion was made and carried that the May minutes be approved as described in the Newsletter.

Marilynn Kroeker provided members with our EScrip Group ID #10696993 that can be utilized for purchases from businesses like Vons. Marilyn also shared information about Dream Dinners, which has a new location in San Marcos. It's a new business where meal ingredients are already prepared and ready for people to assemble and cook multiple meals for your family. Marilyn is going to check into the possibility of CWONC members going as a group, and also maybe getting them to speak at one of our meetings.

It was time to vote on the proposed amendments to CWONC's By-Laws, however there were not enough members present to constitute a quorum, therefore the vote will take place during the July meeting.

Project status: Ann Lygas reminded members about the Blue Ribbon judging taking place at the San Diego Fair and said to contact her with any questions. Laura McPhee thanked everyone for all of their help and donations for the Mother's Day Tea, which was a great success clearing approximately \$2500. Melanie Noble shared that since she has had so much trouble making arrangements to donate to Cause for Paws she would like to change the donation amount of \$100 to Friends of County Animal Shelters (FOCAS), still focusing on animals. Melanie will let Linda Bridges know of the change. Vivian Doering shared that a meeting was scheduled with Laura Collins to discuss a joint event with the Escondido Women's Club, and asked about dates in October. There will be information to come.

New business: Vivian Doering asked if someone in CWONC would put together two baskets valued at \$75, one for Interfaith and one for the Children's Museum.

Vivian will donate the \$75 for each basket and she just needs someone to assemble the baskets. They would be donated on behalf of CWONC, getting our name out. Laura suggested that she could provide certificates for our Mother's Day Tea that could be included in the baskets.

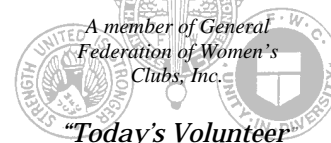

**BY-LAWS OF THE  
CONTEMPORARY WOMEN OF NORTH COUNTY**  
**Proposed Amendments for July 2006 IN RED - Comments in Blue**

**Section III - Membership**

- Section 7: A prospective member shall be considered for full membership when she has met the following provisional conditions:
- a) In attendance of at least three (3) business meetings **Change to (2) business meetings and (1) CWONC outside activity** within a six (6) month period and may be installed at the third meeting provided all below requirements are met.
  - b) Worked at least five (5) hours on Contemporary Women of North County projects.
  - c) Upon completion of provisional membership conditions, dues and fees are paid in full. **ADD: Those women joining after February shall have their dues prorated.**
  - d) New members shall be initiated in January, March, July, September and November. **Change to: New members shall be initiated when appropriate, however not during the month of February.**

**Article IV - OFFICERS AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

- Section 2: The President, Third Vice President, and Treasurer are the only officers to sign blank checks. Each of these officers shall be bonded—**Delete, Bonding will no longer be offered after 2006.** Two of their signatures are required.
- Section 4: The Executive Committee shall consist of said officers listed in Article IV, Section 1, and the following: Parliamentarian, Immediate Past President, and any member serving on the District Executive Board, and the Coordinator. The Coordinator shall be a voting member.- **Delete, we no longer have a coordinator.**
- Section 8: The President and president-elect may be delegates to State Convention. **Change to: The President and a voting club member may be delegates to State Convention- we may not always have a President-Elect**

**Article V - DUTIES OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS**

- Section 1: g. She shall be a co-signer, along with the Treasurer and the Third Vice President, for checks issued by the Club. She shall be bonded.- **Delete, Bonding no longer offered.**
- Section 9: The Immediate past Treasurer shall be chairwoman of the Budget Committee. Members of the Budget Committee are the Auditor, President, Treasurer, First Vice President, Third Vice President, and Past President. She shall present a proposed Budget to the Executive Committee prior to the Business meeting in March. **Change to: She shall present a proposed budget to the Executive Committee prior to the January meeting and voted on by the entire membership at the February meeting.** She shall file the financial audit of the club, including accounts in detail of monies received and expended.

**Section XIV - BONDING**

- Section 1: The Club shall be bonded, per Data blank instructions, with three (3) officers covered. This bonding is for the President, Treasurer and Ways and Means Officer. The bonding fee shall be paid annually to the GFWC California Federation Women's Clubs, Junior Membership, Inc. when Data blanks are returned. **Delete bonding, as bonding is no longer offered.**

**STANDING RULES**

Business meetings shall begin at 7:00 PM **Change to: 6:30 PM- To follow current procedure**

- 10) The club pays for the President's total expenses at District Conferences and Convention and the (3) Vice Presidents' and the Coordinator's- **Delete Coordinator, no longer have a Coordinator** luncheons and registration at District Conferences and Convention.
